2020 3-FELLOW NOMINATION FORM FOR NEW AAAS FELLOWS

A member of the AAAS whose efforts on behalf of the advancement of science or its applications are scientifically or socially distinguished may, by virtue of such meritorious contribution, be elected a Fellow by the Council. A group of three previously-elected AAAS Fellows may serve as sponsors to nominate another AAAS member as a Fellow.

Election as an AAAS Fellow is an honor and all Fellows are expected to meet the commonly held standards of professional ethics and scientific integrity. AAAS encourages diverse nominations that include a fair representation of women, minorities and persons with disabilities.

Special Note for 2020 Nominees:

Eligibility for nomination requires an individual to have been a continuous member (with no lapses in membership) of AAAS since **December 31, 2016** or earlier. Members who joined *after* the **December 31, 2016** cutoff date are **not** eligible for the 2020 cycle. **Verification of nominee eligibility is required in advance of submission.** Please email fellownomination@aaas.org with the nominee name and institution to obtain verification.

Instructions:

Please complete the following four pages of the nomination form. Also, include a full CV and a *complete* list of the nominee's peer-reviewed publications and other major publications such as book chapters, review articles, outreach materials, etc. A separate document listing the nominee's 10 most important papers must be appended. All three sponsors must submit a supporting letter of recommendation. Failure to complete all of the steps will result in a disqualified nomination.

“For distinguished contributions to the field of molecular and translational neuroscience, particularly using somatic cell gene transfer to study neuronal physiology and treat human disease.”

SPONSOR REQUIREMENTS:

- **ALL THREE SPONSORS MUST BE PREVIOUSLY ELECTED FELLOWS & CURRENT IN THEIR MEMBERSHIP AND IN GOOD STANDING.**
- At least two of the three sponsors must be from an institution different from that of the nominee.
- The contact information for all three sponsors is required on the nomination form.
- No Fellow may serve as a sponsor, whether primary, secondary or tertiary, on more than two 3-Fellow nominations in one year.
- The nomination form must be submitted by the primary sponsor.
- It is the primary sponsor's responsibility to ensure that the full submission is received by the AAAS Executive Office by the deadline. No submission that is incomplete or submitted after the deadline will be considered.

LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION REQUIREMENTS:

- All three sponsors must submit a signed supporting letter on letterhead.
- There is also a "3-Fellow Recommendation Letter Addendum" which must be completed and signed by each sponsor, and submitted WITH the letter of recommendation.
- It is important that all three letters in support of a nominee be informational, with a clear indication of the areas in which a nominee has contributed (e.g., research, teaching, technology, service to professional societies, administration in academe, industry or government, etc.) and provide sufficient explanation of why the nominee merits this recognition.
- These may be submitted directly to AAAS from the sponsor or with the full submission packet.

2020 3-FELLOW NOMINATION SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

DEADLINE: APRIL 29, 2020, 11:59 P.M. EASTERN TIME

Requirements:

- Nominee has been verified by the Executive Office as a continuous member (with no lapses in membership) of AAAS since December 31, 2016.*
- All three sponsors are previously elected Fellows of AAAS.
- All three sponsors are current in their AAAS membership and in good standing.**
- Sponsors (whether primary, secondary or tertiary) are serving on no more than two nominations in 2020.
- At least two of the three sponsors are from different institutions than that of the nominee.
- It is the primary sponsor's responsibility to ensure all materials are submitted by the deadline.
- All materials (nomination form, full CV, list of top 10 publications and three sponsor letters with addendums) must be received by the deadline for the nominee to be considered as a 2020 Fellow. No exceptions will be made.

Nomination Form:

- Nominee's contact and biographical information.
- Section to which the nominee is forwarded (a key is attached).
- Citation in 25 words or less (page 3).
- Contact information of primary sponsor.
- Contact information of secondary sponsor.
- Contact information of tertiary sponsor.

- Confirm with each sponsor that they are serving on no more than two 2020 Fellow nominations.

Additional Material:

- Nominee's full CV, **including** a complete list of the nominee's peer-reviewed publications and other major publications, such as book chapters, review articles, outreach materials, etc.
- Document listing the top 10 most influential publications by the nominee.
- Recommendation letter (**on letterhead with signature**) and addendum from primary sponsor.
- Recommendation letter (**on letterhead with signature**) and addendum from secondary sponsor. Letters may be sent directly to AAAS from the sponsor.
- Recommendation letter (**on letterhead with signature**) and addendum from tertiary sponsor. Letter may be sent directly to AAAS from the sponsor.
